1st International Girls' Symposium on Energy and Responsibility

Friday, October 4th 2019

The German Aerospace centre, DLR, and the MINT-Girls Regensburg organize a symposium on *Energy and Responsibility* taking place at the DLR in Oberpfaffenhofen. Students representing their respective school from all European countries are invited to participate.

Energy and Responsibility

Not only the global pupils and students movement *Friday for Future* shows todays importance of subjects like climate protection, supply of energy and CO₂ consumption.

What can we do, what can everyone do about it? How can we persuade the „decision makers“ to take responsibility?

How can we ourselves take more responsibility?



Symposium: (scientific) exchange

Every school may designate up to five students representing their respective school on the symposium. Each school involves in the event with a poster (size Din A0, portrait format, English language).

Examples for poster contributions:

- Which projects on the topics energy / climate / responsibility exist at my school?
- How does a dye-sensitized solar cell (Graetzel cell) work – and why can this be considered a fascinating alternative to conventional photovoltaics?
- Desertec – electrical power harnessing in deserts
- urban niche solutions – on-shore wind power in municipal architecture

Poster session

A poster session is a specific kind of scientific conference: the participants walk from poster to poster while the authors wait beside their posters to present and elucidate their topic and field questions and discussions. In this way everyone deals intensively with many topics in a short period of time.

International

Energy revolution and climate change, limitation of global warming or reduction of the CO₂ emission – all these topics shall be treated in a global context.

For this reason the symposium is supported internationally: participants from Israel, Austria and Germany will attend.
